# Route to Antarctica

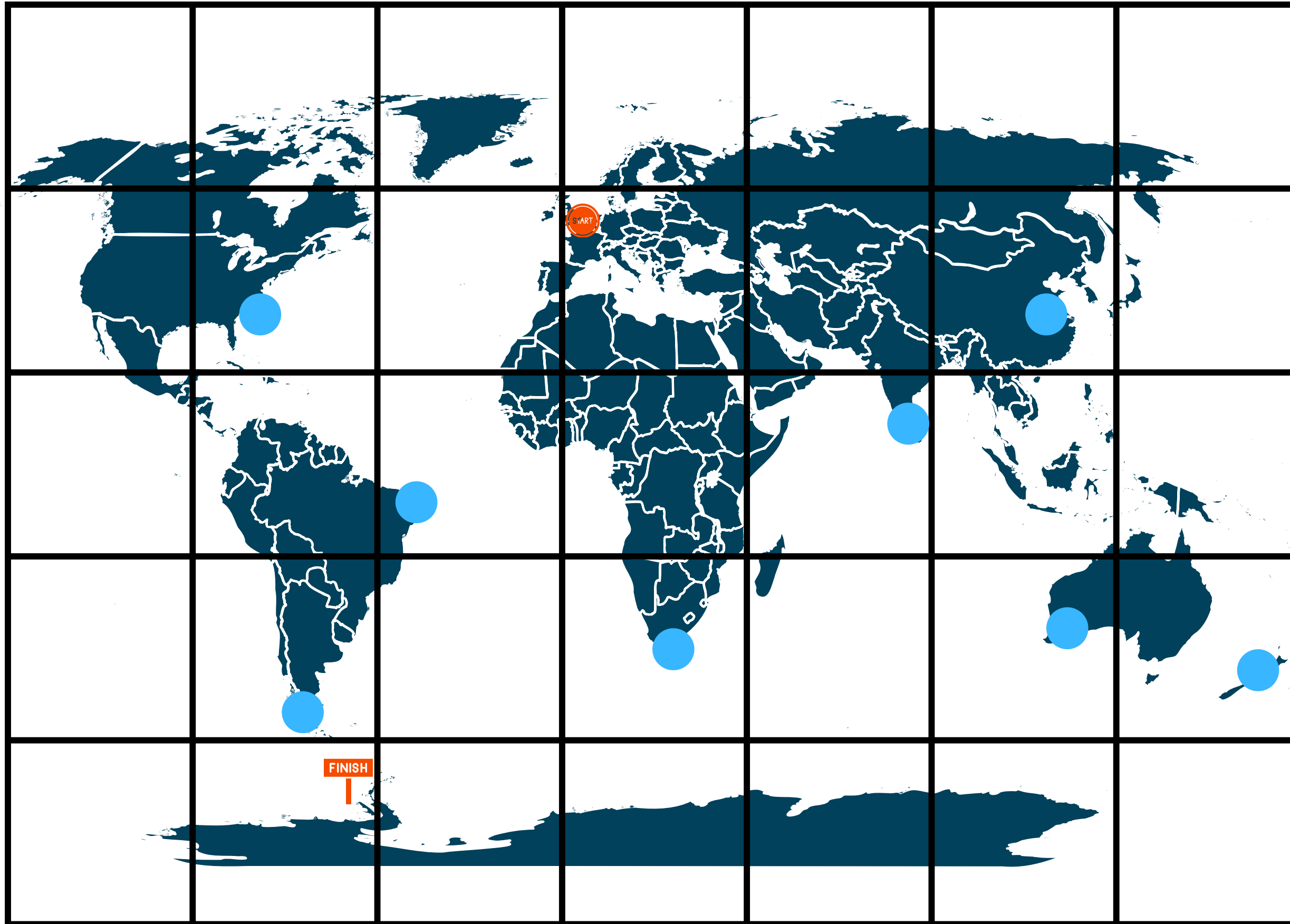

## Key.

 = Supply ports

1 square flying = £5,000

1 square sailing = £2,000



### Challenge Card

You have run into a storm and used more fuel than you planned. Go to a supply port to refill and pay the refueling price.

### Challenge Card

One of your crew has taken ill. Stop at your nearest supply port (even if that is behind you) to get them medical attention.

### Challenge Card

Your engine is running slower than it should be. From this point forward, each square visited will use double the amount of fuel.

### Challenge Card

You have encountered freezing conditions - miss a turn.

### Challenge Card

You have had equipment failure - pay £1,000 for repairs.

### Challenge Card

There is an issue with your travel documents and you are held at port - miss a turn.

### Challenge Card

Faulty equipment needs replacing. Pay £500.

### Challenge Card

A medical issue arises on board. Pay £3,000 for supplies.

### Challenge Card

Your food supply has gone bad. Stop at your next supply port and pay £5,000 to replace it.

### Challenge Card

You realise you need an additional specialist for the investigations you are completing in the field. Pick them up at the next supply port.

**Opportunity Card**

You have spotted and logged a rare species.

**Gain 1 eco point**

**Opportunity Card**

Your route takes advantage of good weather. Advance to the next to the next square for free.

**Opportunity Card**

An environmental charity has sponsored your trip. Get one round of supplies for free.

**Opportunity Card**

You pick up scientists from a different expedition in your next port. This saves them money.

**Gain 1 eco point**

**Opportunity Card**

You map plastic pollution in an uncharted area of the planet which can be used to help people manage it.

**Gain 1 eco point**

**Opportunity Card**

A large medical corporation has donated a specialist medical kit for free.  
**Keep this card in case you need it.**

**Opportunity Card**

You have struck up an excellent relationship with indigenous communities along your route and help tell their story to the wider community.  
**Gain 1 eco point for every square you have already travelled.**

**Opportunity Card**

Your travel brings employment to the people helping you along your journey.  
**Gain 1 eco point for each port you have already visited.**

**Opportunity Card**

You are using biofuel for your travels.  
**Gain 2 eco points.**

**Opportunity Card**

Most of your equipment is powered from renewable energy sources.  
**Gain 4 eco points.**
